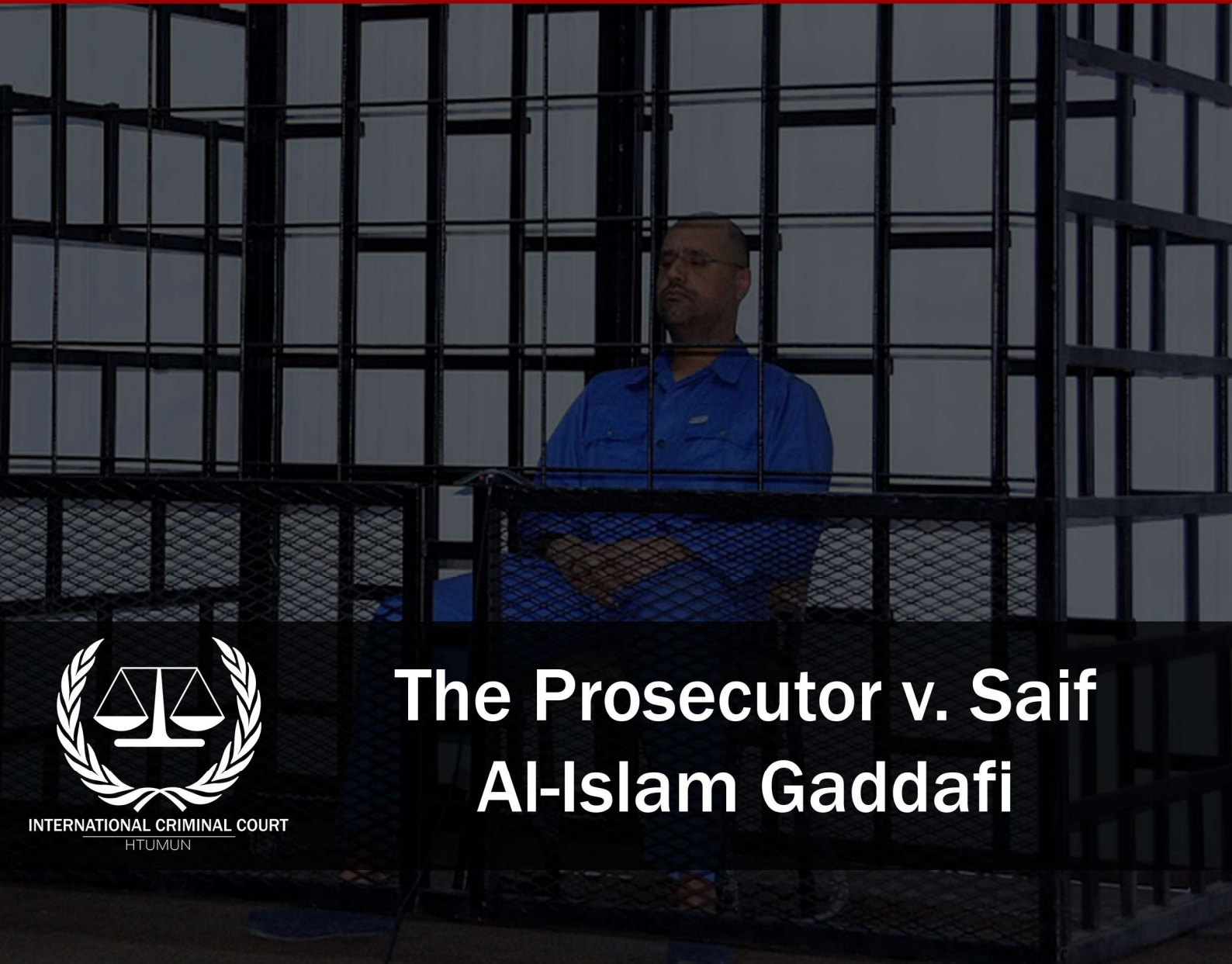

**The Prosecutor v. Saif  
Al-Islam Gaddafi**



## Brief Background

Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi is a Libyan political figure. The second son of the former Libyan leader Muammar Gaddafi from his wife Safia Farkash. He was part of his father's most trusted inner circle, executing public relations and diplomatic roles on his behalf. Although he publicly refused down his father's offer of the second highest post of government officials. After the death of Muammar and Muttassim, Saif-Al Islam was the only member of the Gaddafi family left in Libya, quote on quote **"I am in Libya, I am alive and free and willing to fight to the end and take revenge"**

The ICC is asking the government about Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi's detention, note that the new government being unwilling to comply with the ICC's information requests. Further note that the most recent deadline demands have also been ignored. This court is going to affirm the indictment of the extradition to The Hague Court if the Libyan government fails to show that Saif Al-Islam will face the same charges in Libya as he did in the ICC. Libya will be reported to the Security Council for further investigations.

The ICC is demanding the immediate delivery of Saif Al-Islam al Gaddafi according to the UN charter alongside the Rome Statute. The inability or the refusal of delivery of Saif Al-Islam will lead to the whole Libyan government to endure the full political power of the UN, ICJ, SC and the ICC.
